Introduction

The Barnes and Noble Nook Simple Touch Reader is a portable reading device available for loan from the Bayberry Elementary School Library. This device is the size of a paperback book and is capable of holding hundreds of books. It also provides students with tools and features allowing readers to make the reading experience interactive and engaging, such as inserting notes, changing the font, and using a dictionary.

The option to borrow this device is a privilege, which requires special permission for students and the cooperation of parents/guardians. Should the Nook be damaged, the replacement cost will be charged.
